GROWING SEASON

The 2020 season recorded the earliest harvest in Mendoza's history. The exceptional health of the fruit stands out, providing well-structured wines with great balance and flavor concentration. In a warm climate, the strategic planning of the harvest points and logistics were key to achieving freshness, good acidity and maturity at its exact point to achieve excellent wines.

HARVEST

- Hand-harvest with shears
- Harvest date: March 10 to March 23

WINEMAKING

- Manual bunch selection
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% spontaneous malolactic fermentation
- Aged 10 months in French oak; 10% new
- Bottled unfiltered, February 2021
- Varietal composition: 72% Malbec, 18% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot, 5% Cabernet Franc

TASTING NOTES

Bright intense violet color. Aromas of plums, black fruit, Asian spices and Andean herbal notes. Great personality and balance, good energy, juicy with fine tannins.
