VINEYARD

-Appellation: Valle de Uco -Region: Los Árboles

-Vineyard: Chañares Estate

-Height: 3,888 feet

-Vineyard age: 15 years

-Soil: rocky, with good drainage and aeration. Sandy-loamy texture with the presence of gravel and boulders with calcareous sediments. Roots with important deep development and abundant lateral growth.

GROWING SEASON

The 2019 harvest was marked by two decisive factors: the great thermal amplitude and the low rainfall. The first, allowed to reach an optimum concentration of the grape, fineness in the grain of the tannins, good acidity and moderate potential alcohols. On the other hand, the second guaranteed ideal health conditions throughout the harvest period. This combination made it possible to obtain bunches of excellent quality.

HARVEST

- Hand-harvest with shears
- Harvest date: March 19 to April 10

WINEMAKING

- Manual selection of clusters and grains.
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% spontaneous malolactic fermentation
- Aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 50% new.
- Bottled unfined, November 2020
- Varietal composition: 100% Malbec

TASTING NOTES

Brilliant red with violet tones and good nuance. Aromas of pink pepper, red fruit, and cigar box. In the mouth, fine grain tannins are perceived, a vibrant backbone and lingering finish.
