- Appellation: Valle de Uco
- Region: Los Árboles
- Vineyard: Chañares Estate
- Height: 3,888 feet
- Ha: 17
- Vineyard age: 15 years
- Soil: rocky, with good drainage and aeration. Sandy-loamy texture with the presence of gravel and boulders with calcareous sediments. Roots with important deep development and abundant lateral growth.

GROWING SEASON

The 2019 harvest was marked by two decisive factors: the great thermal amplitude and the low rainfall. The first, allowed to reach an optimum concentration of the grape, fineness in the grain of the tannins, good acidity and moderate potential alcohols. On the other hand, the second guaranteed ideal health conditions throughout the harvest period. This combination made it possible to obtain bunches of excellent quality.

HARVEST

- Hand-harvest with shears
- Harvest date: March 19 to March 26

WINEMAKING

- Manual selection of clusters and grains.
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% spontaneous malolactic fermentation
- Aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 50% new.
- Bottled unfiltered, November 2020
- Varietal composition: 100% Cabernet Franc

TASTING NOTES

Bright in red color with dark tones. Aromas of Andean herbs, pink pepper and gooseberries, with hints of mint and cinnamon. On the palate the wine is angular and focused, with fine tannins, good concentration and balance, long finish.
