VINEYARD

- Appellation: Lujan de Cuyo
- Region: Agrelo
- Vineyard: Hobbs Estate
- Altitude: 3,264 feet
- Ha: 13,7
- Vineyard age: 11 years
- Soil: First layer with a higher proportion of clay that covers the first 10cm to 40 cm. Then a sandy loam texture appears that allows good water drainage. Some round stone profiles appear in deep.

GROWING SEASON

The 2019 harvest was marked by two decisive factors: the great thermal amplitude and the low rainfall. The first, allowed to reach an optimum concentration of the grape, fineness in the grain of the tannins, good acidity and moderate potential alcohols. On the other hand, the second guaranteed ideal health conditions throughout the harvest period. This combination made it possible to obtain bunches of excellent quality.

HARVEST

- Hand-harvest with shears
- Harvest date: March 26 to April 14

WINEMAKING

- Manual selection of clusters and grains.
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% spontaneous malolactic fermentation
- Aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 50% new.
- Bottled unfiltered, November 2020
- Varietal composition: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

Ruby red color with dark tones. Aromas of figs, black fruit and dark chocolate. On the palate, balanced, with round tannins, good complexity and a long finish.
