## VINEYARD

- Appellation: Luján de Cuyo
- Region: Agrelo
- Vineyard: Hobbs Estate
- Altitude: 3,264 feet
- Ha: 13,7
- Vineyard age: 11 years
- Soil: First layer with a higher proportion of clay that covers the first 10cm to 40 cm. Then a sandy loam texture appears that allows good water drainage. Some round stone profiles appear in deep.

## GROWING SEASON

The 2020 season recorded the earliest harvest in Mendoza's history. The exceptional health of the fruit stands out, providing well-structured wines with great balance and flavor concentration. In a warm climate, the strategic planning of the harvest points and logistics were key to achieving freshness, good acidity and maturity at its exact point to achieve excellent wines.

## HARVEST

- Hand-harvest with shears
- Harvest date: March 3 to March 5

## WINEMAKING

- Manual selection of clusters and grains.
- Fermentation in stainless steel tanks
- 100% spontaneous malolactic fermentation
- Aged 18 months in French oak barrels, 50% new.
- Bottled unfiltered, October 2021
- Varietal composition: 100% Malbec

## TASTING NOTES

Deep red color with violet tones, delicate and elegant aromas such as violets, lavender and red fruits the mouthfeel is juicy with sweet tannins and a long finish.
